OFFICE MEMORANDUM

**Subject: Enhancement of the scope of National Urban Livelihoods Mission (NULM) and renaming thereof.**

With a view to improving the livelihood opportunities for the poor in urban areas, it has been decided to enhance the scope of National Urban Livelihoods Mission. The States/UTs may implement all or any of the components of the Mission in all the Statutory Towns based on their local capacity and requirement. The Mission with enhanced scope will be renamed as “**Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana (DAY) – National Urban Livelihoods Mission**”. Accordingly, the following amendments in the NULM Mission document are issued with immediate effect:
